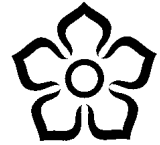

**Appendix 1 - Traffic and Highways Actions**

**Shady Lane / St Deny's Church –**

- Development Plans previously agreed – Update requested.
- Road resurfacing, uneven/ bumpy
- Potholes – Not filled.

- Road signage re vehicle weight - Obscured.
- Revision of the Island layout, outside church/ main problems re traffic.
- Re-think of the road to area following fatal / and critical RTA's.
- Overall Comment – Not Fit for Purpose.

#### **Evington Road –**

##### **(Evington Lane fork, leading to Evington Rd.)**

- Traffic enforcement / parking both side of the road -hazard, obstructing emergency service/ frail elderly/ prams – via Evington Rd, and Whitehall Road.
- Investment in preventing speeding.

#### **Spencefield Lane –**

- Traffic enforcement / parking both side of the road -hazard, obstructing emergency service/ frail elderly/ prams.
- Investment in preventing speeding.

#### **Downing Drive –**

- School run – cars driving past the bollards, parking in front of houses preventing residents accessing property.

#### **Marydene Drive –**

- No parking (yellow) lines obscured.
- Pencil bollards down to pavement – prevents grass from being cut.
- Increase height of knee, high railings.

#### **Susan Avenue –**

- Bollards recently installed – situated on crossing area, for people with special needs /obscuring safe access, cross the road.

#### **Mickleson Drive –**

- Install Barriers / Humps prevent speeding.

#### **Miscellaneous Points –**

- What has section 106 Housing money been used for?
- What is the provision for additional pupils / cars in the area, with increased pupils to Avanti School, on Spencefield Lane?
- City of Leicester School - Install Zebra Crossing / Crossing Guide to Downing Drive / Spencefield Lane.
- Impact on traffic/ area from the ring round between Evington and Oadby.
- Leave blocking drains / road – Causing flooding issues.
- Leaves hindering view of yellow road line across the ward.
