Appendix 1 – Highways Update and Upcoming Works

Highways Maintenance Works

Narborough Road resurfacing (as part of joint works with Leicestershire County Council) has just started and is programmed to go through to the end of November.

Bridge works on Golf Course Lane are being planned. Should be onsite next year.

We continue to inspect the footways and carriageways around the ward and in the last 12 months have found actionable defects as follows:

- Carriageway - 335 orders
- Footway - 170 orders

We are installing 3 bollards on Fulhurst Avenue to stop driving along the wide footway near the shops.

School Streets

St Mary's Fields Primary signed up this academic year for WOW [WOW - the walk to school challenge | Living Streets](#)

They did extremely well with WOW during Spring and Summer terms. They have re-enrolled this autumn but have not been doing so well in terms of engagement so we are working with the WOW Champion at the school at ways to boost engagement and are discussing the possibility of setting

up a pupil group (WOW Champions) to lead on WOW. Nothing is confirmed as yet but we'll keep you posted.

Caldecote Community Primary has a school sting operation planned for December. Sorry we won't tell you the date!

Ellesmere College – we continue with ongoing work to promote the Park & Stride site at Premier Inn for the families that bring pupils by private car. We held a pledge / meet the parent event in September and spoke to around 30 parents to explain how they could apply for permission to park at the site and to talk about active travel in general. We have also tentatively confirmed a pop-up stand at their parent evening in March to keep pushing for uptake.
