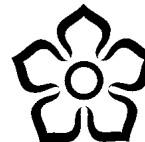

Appendix A

Evington W/M 8th July 24

Traffic and Highways:

- Shady Lane – Larger, more prominent signs re weight restrictions / prohibited, information on enforcement of the restrictions, requested.
- Spencefield Lane – B road, Sign size request to make bigger, requires cleaning for visibility.
- Downing Drive / Uppingham Road Junction – Safety issue – Entry Road, traffic light system requested.
- Middleton Drive, as turns left into Spencefield Lane, left hand side, cars parking on double yellow lanes.
- Working in conjunction with the police to look at enforcement re parking 20 feet near a junction – Cllrs. requested collaborative approach.
- Speeding Query - Breakdown of speeds monitoring on east area, in particularly Evington ward.
- Yellow Lines - Resurfacing / Repaint of depleted yellow line road markings within the ward.
- Enforcement / Tickets Issued – Number of tickets issued, between Downing Drive, and Whitehall Road, and Spencefield Lane, requested?
- Spencefield Lane - Information requested on access issues, for emergency services, and public transport.
- Middleton – Double yellow lines ignored; what action can be taken.
- Enforcement of double yellow lines is LCC not police, please confirm?
- Spencefield Lane – Trees require trimming at the base from Davenport Road.
- Evington Lane – Cycle Lanes lights require washing / cleaning.
