

Appendix A – Highways Update

Highways Maintenance Works

We continue to inspect the footways and carriageways around the ward and repair actionable defects as we find them on our inspections. In the last 6 months we have identified and repaired the following defects:

- Carriageway = 81 repairs
- Footway = 123 repairs

Works completed 23/24

- Hungarton Boulevard – Carriageway Resurfacing (linked with local safety scheme) completed August 2023.
- Hungarton Boulevard – Traffic Signal Renewal (linked with local safety scheme) completed January 2024. The traffic signals work at these sites included a complete refresh of all the street furniture which will improve the look of the area as well as taking advantage of modern Extra Low Voltage LED technologies that will use much less power and therefore generate much less CO2.
- Cardinals Walk – (Lynmouth Road to Wigley Road) Carriageway Resurfacing – Completed March 2024
- Maidenwell Ave/Burnett Close – Traffic Signal Renewal completed November 2024

Works Programmed 24/25

- Uppingham Road (Humberstone Drive to junction of Scraptoft Lane including up to the entrance of shell petrol station) – Carriageway Resurfacing

School Streets

We have done a lot of School Run Parking work at both Kestrels Mead Junior and Infant sites at Maidenwell Avenue and Mundesley Road/Bessingham Close. There are a few more wooden knee rails to go in at Bessingham Close. Residents indicate that they would like a school street scheme, but it is difficult to implement due to too many properties being behind the closure point.

We have also completed School Run Parking work at Scraptoft Valley school - Local residents would like further improvements, but we need to share the finite budget around schools where little School Run Parking work has been done.

Other Schemes.

We have had a lot of interaction with Cllr Bonham regarding the work at the Netherhall Road shops. Much of this is a Housing/Estates scheme, but Highways are leading on the repairs to the surface water sewer connection and engaging with Cllr Bonham over the Neighborhood Street Scene Improvement Project.

Appendix B – Housing Update

WE continuously tackle the issues with anti-social behavior with the area and we are actively working with the Police and Community Safety to overcome them. The local letting policy introduced in September last year has shown massive improvements but we still have some way still to change behavior and it is key local resident keep reporting issues.

We are working on improvement within the communal area of block of flats but completing enhanced cleaning and tackling weeds and moss in the surrounding area to tackle grout spot to enhance the living environment for our tenant.
