> I live on [REDACTED] would like to lodge my objection to the license application for L'Amore Dessert Parlour to extend its closing times [REDACTED] This is because over the year I have noticed more litter on the streets directly linked to local takeaways. There has also been a steady increase in anti-social behaviour such as groups hanging around in the streets, loud music and cars speeding, all until the early hours (usually ending about an hour after the businesses close), especially right outside [REDACTED] where I regularly find takeaway food and rubbish strewn across the pavement. Recently there has been a marked improvement in the reduction of these behaviours. It happens to have coincided with a number of late night licenses being declined, businesses operating outside of their planning conditions being given notices to close on time and changes to the parking situations in the area. I feel, should L'Amore be allowed to extend their hours, this will not only impact the reductions in littering and anti social behaviour, on Evington Road and the nearby streets, but more importantly encourage other businesses to apply to also extend their operating hours. This would cause a flood of businesses to stay open until the early morning hours, changing the area from a mainly residential area to a late night hot spot that will further exacerbate the levels of anti social behaviour in the local area. I therefore feel 11pm is a good time for the business to close as this is when the residents will be sleeping or preparing to sleep, it is also a well established closing time for the vast majority of businesses in the area so residents will already be accustomed to planning their schedules (such as finding their overnight parking) to these times.
