2.	Portishead Road	
	- Ongoing Issues with parking along the road, preventing safe access for Vehicles to use the road. A lot of cars parked along the road by the local garage and lots of HGV lorries parked there during busy times bringing supplies to the Umrah Supermarket as well as Industrial Units along the road. Possible introductions of double yellow lines near the bottom of Portishead Road or possible making it a one-way system. - Garage along Portishead Road have been visited number of times and asked to move cars into forecourt. - Access from Portishead Road to Craven Park blocked by cars making it difficult for parks to gain access to the Craven to cut the grass, cones have been used in the past, but they just get moved. Suggestion made of have having bollards put there to solve this problem (possible funding through ward funding). - Abandoned Garage Forecourt on Portishead Road is overgrown and rubbish being dumped, needs cleaning and finding out who owns the land.
