

LCC pre-school setting project group**Sufficiency assessment:**

The 14 settings currently within the LCC portfolio sit within all 6 CYPF cluster areas and cover 11 different wards of the city.

West cluster:

There are 2 LCC settings located within the West Cluster, one in the Braunstone Park and Rowley Fields ward and the other in the Western ward.

The cluster as a whole has 21 additional PVI providers; 11 schools and 37 registered childminders (14 of whom are signed up to deliver funded places for 2, 3 or 4 year olds)

There are 4,636 children aged 0-4 years (as per estart data), with 494 eligible 2 year olds, 1,005 3 year olds and 973 4 year olds.

Braunstone Park and Rowley Fields ward

The Brite Early Years provision is located in this ward along with 3 PVI providers, 5 Primary schools and 18 childminders (7 registered for Funded place delivery)

The above sufficiency information shows that in the Braunstone Park and Rowley Fields wards there are more than enough places available for the population of 3 and 4 year olds and there is a 90% place availability for eligible 2 year olds, with a 58% take up rate this is again sufficient place availability.

For the western ward again there are far more places available for 3 and 4 year olds than the population in existence at the moment, and there is 79% place availability for eligible 2 year olds, again with a take up rate of 64% this is adequate in terms of sufficiency at the current time.

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East cluster:

There are 2 LCC settings in the East cluster – Coleman Playgroup in the Evington ward and Little Tykes Playgroup in the Thurncourt ward.

The cluster as a whole has an additional 8 PVI providers, 11 schools, and 29 childminders (12 of whom are registered to deliver funded places)

There are 3542 children aged 0-4 years across the cluster including 310 eligible 2 year olds; 806 3 year olds and 761 4 year olds.

Coleman playgroup is located in the Evington ward along with a further 2 PVI providers, 4 Primary schools (including one free school) and 11 childminders (of whom 5 are registered to deliver funded places)
