BINS ON STREETS

Following complaints from residents, several properties throughout the ward have been issued with S46 legal notices in regards to their bins. There has been a definite improvement and compliance with the notices.



UNTIDY PRIVATE LAND

There have been a lot of complaints about fly-tipping and waste left on land that isn't maintained by the Council. I have contacted landowners and steps have been made to clear the sites.



ILLEGAL WASTE CARRIERS & FLY TIPPING

In an attempt to counter fly-tipping, I have been working with Enviro Crime and Gypsum Close to catch businesses misusing the site and potential rogue traders that are also tipping waste in the surrounding areas. Reports have been received about private car parks being used as illegal waste transfer sites and these are being investigated. Investigations continue in response to fly-tips throughout the ward.

GENERAL

Patrols continue throughout the ward, dealing with fly tips, littering and any other issues that are encountered. We continue to receive a high volume of complaints about issues in the ward and these are dealt with as quickly as possible.
