More S46 Notices and contravention letters have been issued to properties on various streets due to bins being left on the street. However, although there are a couple of hotspots, this is not a major issue in Troon.

PRIVATE LAND

This continues to be a major issue throughout Troon. We have had several areas of private land cleared since the last meeting, including the removal of a vehicle. Some of this work is still ongoing, and land owners have received fines and costs for non-compliance. Residents worked together in one location to have a shared garage area cleared.









FLY TIPPING

Following a rise in fly-tipping at several locations, the Enviro Crime team are monitoring several hotspots in Troon. I have issued a FPN in response to Fly-tipping on Barkbythorpe Road and investigations continue. In other instances, warnings have been issued to residents and they have cleared their waste from the street immediately.
