- Has UHL &/or the CCGs met with the Committee or its representatives to discuss any concerns raised about the implementation of the proposals?
- Has UHL & the CCGs provided the Committee more detailed information around the sustainability of existing services at the Leicester General Hospital once the Level 3 services have been removed. Again can it be put into the public domain?
- Public engagement on the major reconfiguration plans has taken place. Across the city and counties there was disappointment expressed in the content of engagement events also turnout was low at many events. Are the JHOSC satisfied that engagement was adequate?
