**Re: License Application N° 088223 Red Apple Supermarket**

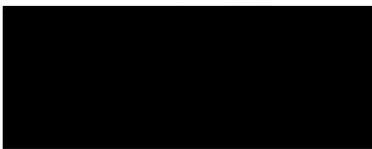
Thank you for the information regarding the above mentioned Supermarket and their application to retail alcohol.
