Re: License Application N° 088223 Red Apple Supermarket


Thank you for the information regarding the above mentioned Supermarket and their application to retail alcohol.

However, if a licence is issued to the said store, may I recommend that it is for a trial period to ascertain whether the alcoholics are attracted back to the area and if so, what effect has it had on the residents of Hannam Court.
