## **Appendix 1**

The traffic regulation orders for the closures at Knighton Drive and Craighill Road are now permanent. Designs underway to make the infrastructure permanent and will be consulted upon once we know that they can be funded.

The school street on Northfold Road and Eastcourt Road is continuing to be monitored, and new ways of operating the school street are being investigated.

The 12 pencil bollards we're going to install on London outside the Islamic Academy will be in Knighton Ward. No other bollards have been installed in the Ward.

In the last 12 months 699 footway repairs were issued (majority of the roads have old, slabbed footways) and 404 carriageway repairs.
