Appendix 1 – City Warden Update

Lots of work has been done regarding the commercial waste bins on Draper Street and it is also being followed up along Evington Road.

Devana Road - outside No. 4 is a terrible fly tipping hotspot and this is also being worked on and several investigations are being done at this time.

Bins on streets residential in the area will be starting from 25th / 26th April and will include all streets of Evington Road.

Fly tipping hotspots around St Stephens Road are being investigated also. This area will be the second stage of the residential bins.

20 St James Road - all works have been completed and the sight has now been boarded up. With regards to cars for sale, investigated, no reports have been sent so no actions have been done on this.

Bulky waste and fly tipping to be promoted in the ward – this is ongoing daily work.

It is the responsibility of all residents and property owners to maintain all alleyways, not Leicester City Council. Legal notices will be issued to all residents and property owners and legal actions may be taken against all parties should no actions be completed.
