- 1.1. This report provides information for Members about an application made under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome of that application.

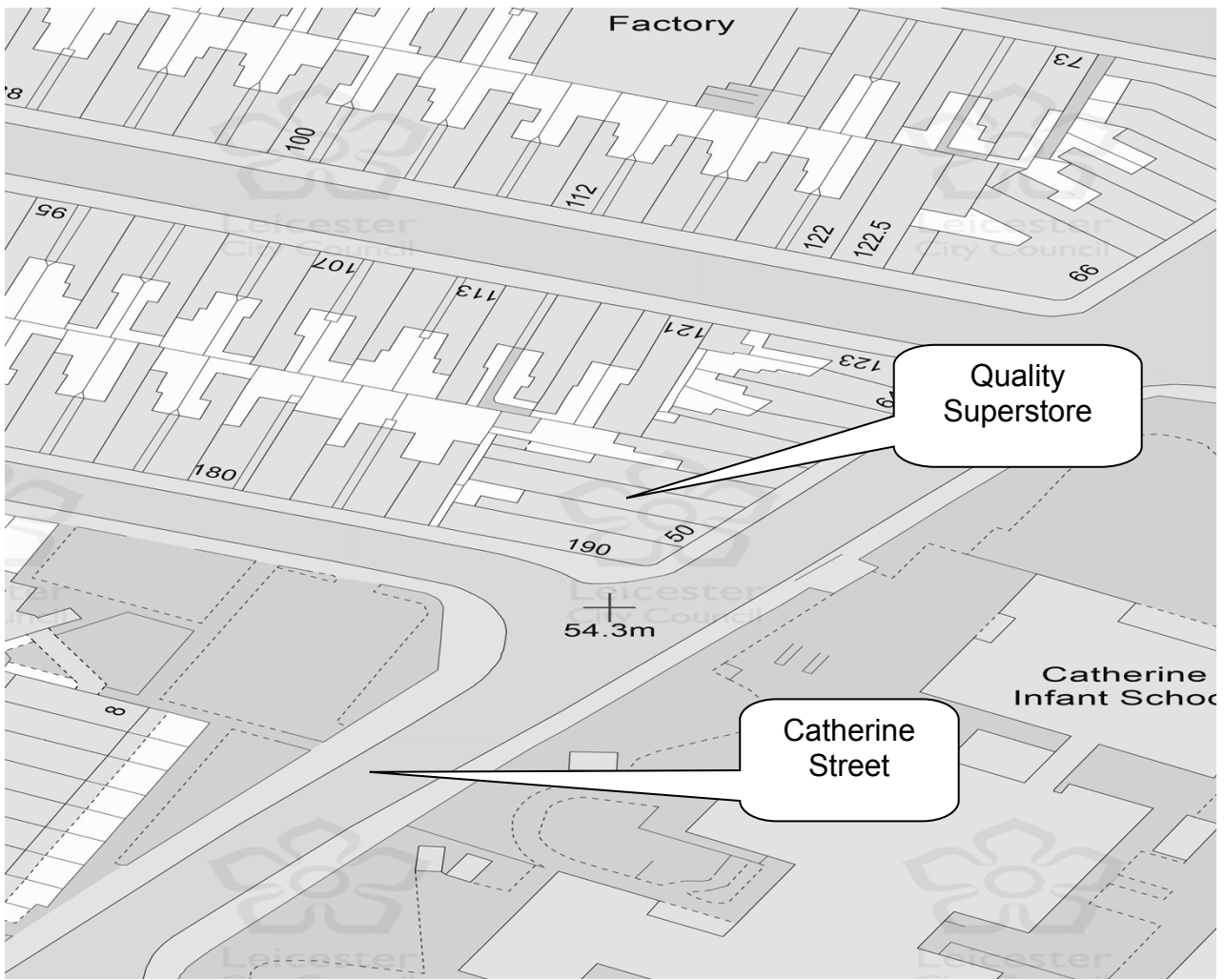
2. Determination to be made

- 3.1 This report outlines an application for a variation to an existing premises licence for Quality Superstore and summarises the representations received. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

5. Existing Licence

5.1. The existing licence is attached at Appendix A.

6. Application

6.1 An application was received on 8th November 2016 from Quality Superstore Ltd for a variation to an existing premises licence for Quality Superstore. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix B.

6.2 The variation sought by the application is as follows:

- 8.1 A representation was received on 6th December 2016 from Leicestershire Police. The representation relates to the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance. Leicestershire Police are concerned that the area suffers from street drinking which is causing anti-social behaviour, noise and litter problems. 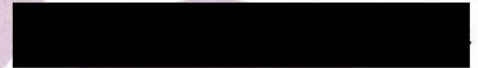

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-

- a) a holographic mark, or
- b) an ultraviolet feature.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The licence holder will ensure that proof of age is requested when necessary e.g passport, driving licence or citizen card

The licence holder will ensure that they have a refusal book.

The licence holder will ensure that children are restricted on the premises

The licence holder will ensure Health and Safety is complied with at all times

The licence holder will ensure that rubbish bins and glass refuse are kept at the rear of the premises

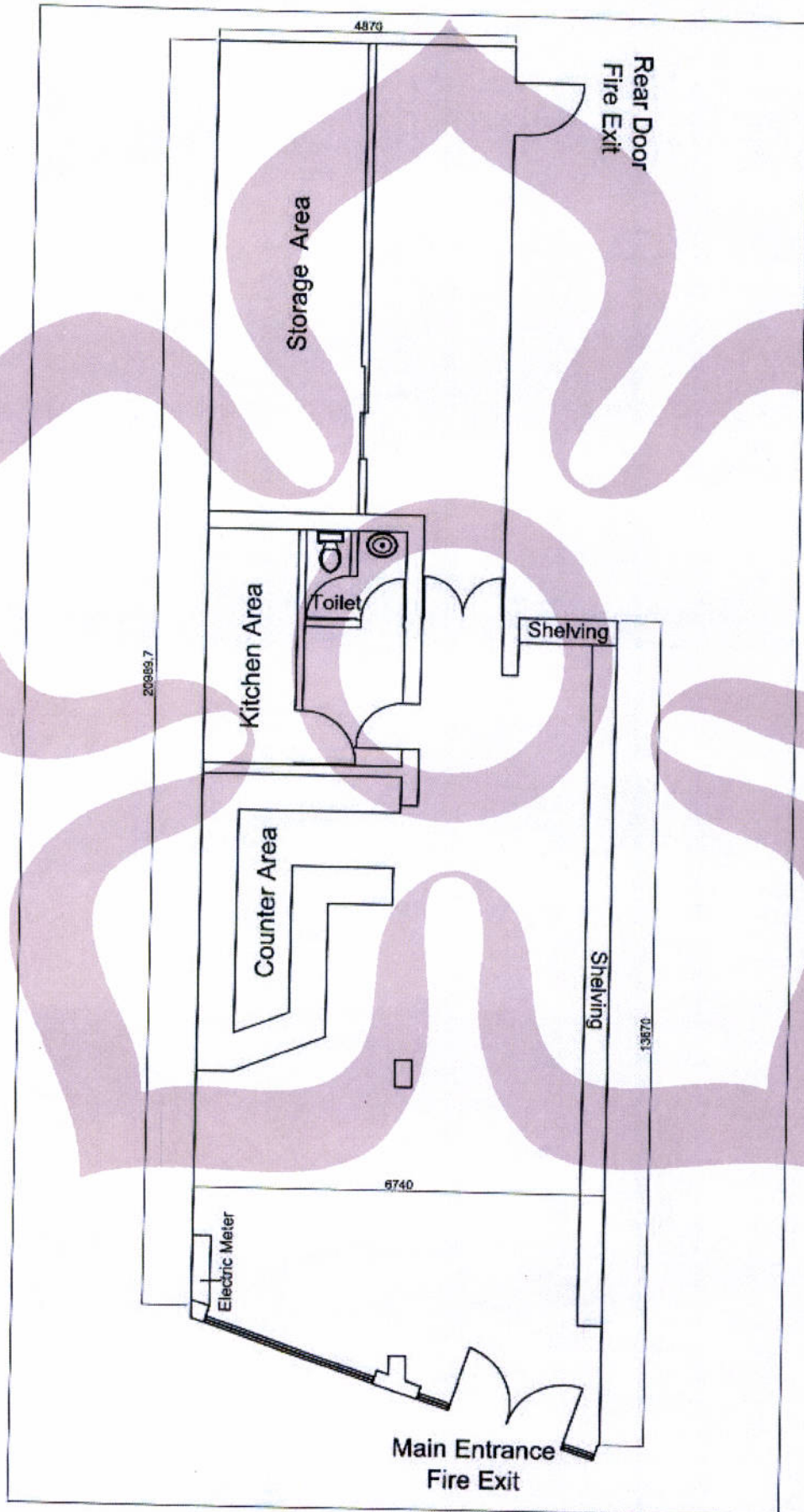
The licence holder will ensure that windows and doors will be closed if it causes too much nuisance

<p>I write in my capacity as a licensing officer for Leicestershire Police on the authority delegated to me by the Chief Constable.</p> <p>My representation relates to the Licensing Objectives of Prevention Of Crime & Disorder & Prevention of Public Nuisance.</p> <p>This application relates to a shop located in a highly residential area and directly opposite Catherine Infant School.</p> <p>The applicant is looking to substantially vary the present licence in relation to the supply of alcohol. The change would see alcohol available from 6.00am in the morning instead of 8.00am and until 1.00am in the early hours of the morning. These</p>

changes are requested to be available every day of the week.

There are a number of shops on Catherine St with licences to supply alcohol, three of these are in close proximity.

The maximum hours a licence in this area allows for the supply of alcohol at a shop is between 7.00am and midnight.

The area suffers from a high incidence of street drinking carried out by Asian males. Many of these males are employed at factories in the area and will purchase alcohol after finishing their shifts and then drink in groups before heading home. Much of this drinking is carried out on parks and car parks in the vicinity with these large groups causing noise and litter problems which in turn cause distress to local residents.

There have been 6 Sentinel incidents recorded for the Catherine Street area relating to street drinking. Sentinel is the multi-agency anti-social behaviour recording system

Were this variation to be granted it would allow people to obtain alcohol at a time which could have the greatest impact on anti-social behaviour and potentially increase the amount of problems already being experienced.

The applicant has offered two conditions to promote the licensing objectives, CCTV installed and to ensure no drinking takes place outside/inside the premises. The steps put forward on the application do not, in the opinion of Leicestershire Police, sufficiently ensure anti-social behaviour will not occur and that the Licensing Objectives of crime and disorder or preventing public nuisance will be promoted.

Leicestershire Police therefore request that the application to vary the opening hours of this premises is refused.
