Report of the Director of Neighbourhood and Environmental Services

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. This report provides information for Members about an application made under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome of that application.

2. Determination to be made

- 2.1. Having considered the application and representation, Members must consider whether to:
- having regard to the Police representation, reject the application if they consider it necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective;
 - or
 - grant the application.

3. Summary

- 3.1 This report outlines an application to transfer an existing premises licence and vary the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) for Oasis Convenience Store, 4-6 Henley Road and summarises the representation received. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

6 Application

6.1 An application was received on the 17 July 2017 from A.C. Consultancy (Licensing Services) on behalf of Mr Osman Mahmood to transfer the existing premises licence for Oasis Convenience Store, 4-6 Henley Road into Mr Osman Mahmood's name and to specify himself as the Designated Premises Supervisor. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix B.

7 Representation

7.1 A representation was received on 28 July 2017 from Leicestershire Police in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder. Leicestershire Police are concerned that the licensing objective of the prevention of crime and disorder will be undermined and have requested that Mr Mahmood is not named as the DPS. A copy of the representation is attached at Appendix C.

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The licence holder will ensure all members of staff are trained in respect of procedures relating to liquor licensing/sale of alcohol.

The licence holder shall ensure CCTV is installed at the premises

The licence holder will have the right to refuse entry to any undesirables.

The licence holder will ensure a proof of age scheme is in place where identification is required from any persons appearing to be under the age of 18 attempting to purchase alcohol.

The licence holder shall comply with all the requirements of health and safety legislation.

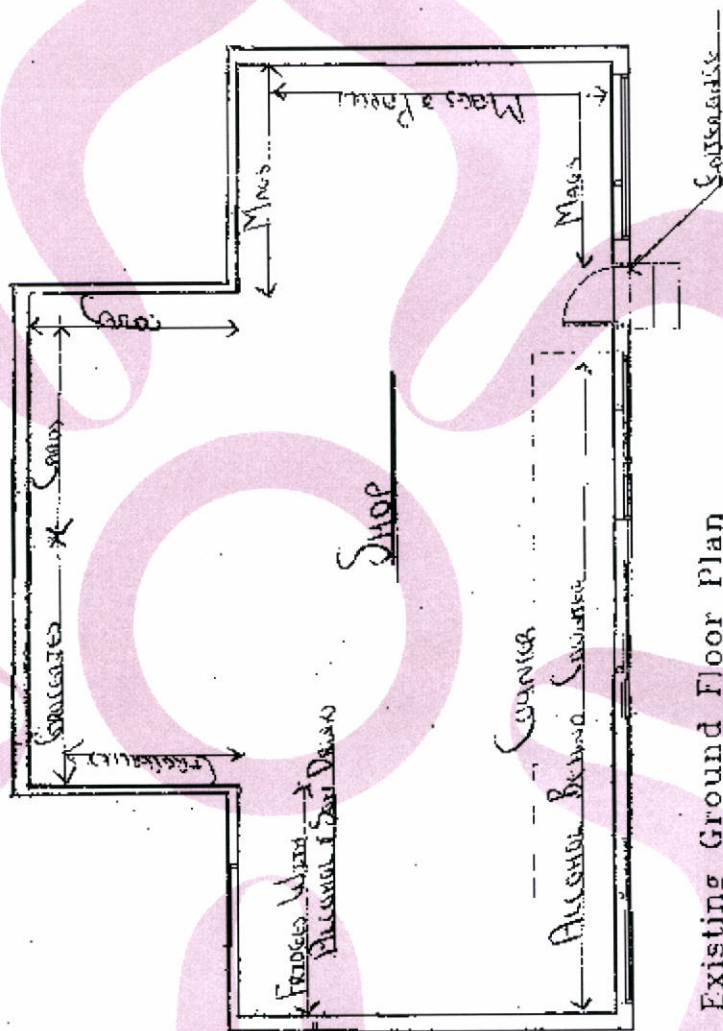

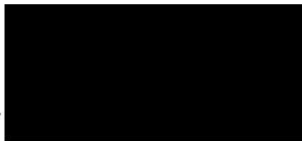



MAHMOOD retained these positions until 11th July 2016.</p> <p>During his short tenure there were reports of alcohol sold to drunks, alcohol being exchanged for stolen goods, selling of illicit cigarettes and the failure of an</p>

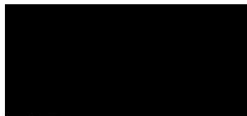
alcohol test purchase by the DPS.

Very recently on the 10th July 2017 MAHMOOD was sentenced at Leicester and Rutland Magistrates Court for two offences following a Trading Standards targeted operation at the shop in Loughborough on 21st June 2016.

The offences related to 218 packets of cigarettes and 2 packets of rolling tobacco which did not comply with the requirements of Regulation 5 and Contrary to regulations 5, 48(a)(i) and 51 of the Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016 and section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972

MAHMOOD received a disposal of a Community Order of 120 hours unpaid work requirement within 12 months.

Due to the supplied information Leicestershire Police have concerns that the objective of Crime and Disorder will be undermined and request the refusal for MAHMOOD to take up the position of DPS.
