Background

- The existing strategy ends on March 31st 2019
- A new draft strategy has been co-produced with service users and other stakeholders
- It will run from 2019 to 2022
- It reflects the legislation and guidance



Strategy Development

- It has been developed over the last year with key activities including:
 - Development sessions with the Learning Disability Partnership Board
 - Sessions with 'We Think Group'
 - Meeting with clinical leads Dr Sheppard and Professor John Knight
 - The lead for the LeDeR programme
 - Meetings with carers
 - Meeting with LLR Easy Write group



Key themes

- Reasonable adjustments to access health and social care services
- Equal health and healthy lifestyles
- Employment and college opportunities
- Workforce training and awareness

Next steps

- An action plan will be developed to underpin the strategy
- Delivery of the strategy will be overseen by the Learning Disabilities Partnership
- Regular updates will be presented to the ASC Scrutiny Commission



Consultation

- All consultation material will be in easy read to make sure these are accessible for people with a learning disability.
- The consultation will launch at the end of January and run for 12 week.

 - Online Survey
 - Postal Surveys
