

CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE
A digital CCTV system will continually monitor the premises whilst it is open to the public. It will cover the entry and exit points and record clear, facially recognisable images of everyone entering or leaving the premises.
CCTV footage will be retained for a minimum of 31 days
The CCTV system will be checked every week to ensure it is functioning correctly including checking time and date stamps are accurate and this will be logged.
Only trained staff can access the CCTV footage and will make it available to the responsible authorities upon request
Should the CCTV malfunction this will be logged and immediate steps taken to rectify the system.
An incident log will be maintained at the premises and at least 12 months records kept and will be immediately available to the responsible authorities. All relevant incidences of crime and disorder must be logged.
When the DPS is not the premises, his telephone number will be available at all times.
Spirits will be stored and sold from behind the counter
Shutters are installed on the premises
Signage to remind customers to leave in a quiet and orderly fashion will be placed where it can clearly be seen by customers leaving the premises.
A refusals register recording every incident where a customer has been unable to produce valid ID to prove their age. Records will be kept for a minimum of 12 months and available for inspection by the responsible authorities on request.
All staff involved in the supply of alcohol will be trained in Challenge 25 and training records will be available for inspection.
A written Challenge 25 policy will be in place at the premises and will be available for inspection.
Clear signage will be displayed near entrances and behind the counter advising customers that Challenge 25 is in operation at the premises.
