46. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Members were asked to declare any interests that they may have in the business on the agenda, and/or indicate that Section 106 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992 applied to them.

63. PETITION CONCERNING ADDITIONAL PARKING FOR RESIDENTS IN COLEMAN ROAD

The Service Director, Regeneration, Highways and Transportation submitted a report in response to a petition presented to full Council by Councillor Johnson on the 31 May 2007 on behalf of 148 residents who live at various locations in the city. In responding to the petition, the report stated that it wasn't possible in the short term to provide additional lay bys/parking areas at the eastern end of Coleman Road specifically for residents or visitors. It would only be possible to do so if a residents only parking zone was installed and this was not planned in the short term.

The Chair proposed that Cabinet be requested to include the provision of additional lay bys on Coleman Road as part of the Local Environmental Works programme. This was agreed.
