Please summarise your concerns about this application:
The premises has the potential to cause a noise nuisance to occupiers of flats above adjacent premises if recorded music is played at an unrestricted volume until 0300.

**Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives**

The premise has previously operated until 0300 under a Temporary Event Notice and caused a noise nuisance to flats above an adjacent premises.

Following the noise nuisance witnessed by the Noise and Pollution Team, the DPS has installed a sound limiting device, set at a level that he felt is unlikely to cause a noise nuisance. Since the limiter has been installed, the premises has operated until 0300 without causing a noise nuisance to occupiers of the flats.

The application includes a statement that all music will be played through the noise limiting device set at the level used during previous Temporary Event Notices. I will have no objections to the proposed variation, should it be granted, subject to the addition of the following condition:

**“All amplified music and voice on the premises shall be played through a noise limiting device which is installed, fitted and maintained in such a manner as to control all sources of amplified music and voice at the premises. The level shall be set to the agreement of the Noise and Pollution Team to prevent noise nuisance being caused to the public, and the agreed level shall not be exceeded without the agreement of the Noise and Pollution Team. Once the device is set it should be inaccessible to anyone on the premise other than the licence holder.”**

I shall contact the applicant to request that he formally agrees to this condition. Since the applicant has stated that it is the intention to continue to use the sound limiting device, albeit not formally stated as a propose condition, I feel that it is unlikely that he will object to the inclusion of this condition.

I note that the Noise and Pollution Team has received complaints about noise on Market Street affecting residents of the hotel opposite Bradders. The source at the time may have been either Bradders or the adjacent Mamba bar. Initial investigations suggest that the acoustic insulation scheme for the hotel may not meet the agreed specification to prevent a noise nuisance from these bars, and that at the time of the complaint the noise levels from the bars was not unreasonable for the location.
