

**CONDITIONS**

<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE</b>
The licence holder will train staff to be able to react in an efficient and effective way towards any crime or disorder that they witness so that they are able to prevent any criminal offences.
The licence holder will ensure that all the CCTV cameras are in operation at all times. They will also be continuously checking if all cameras are operating successfully and efficiently.
<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE REPRESENTATION FROM LEICESTERSHIRE POLICE</b>
Customers and delivery drivers/couriers will not be permitted on the premises between closing time to the public and 6pm.
The licence holder will ensure a high definition resolution, coloured CCTV system is installed, operational and recording whilst the premises is open to the public. The system must permit the identification of individuals in all lighting conditions. Cameras must cover all areas that the public have access to, including the entrance/exit and pavement area immediately outside the front of the premises.
The licence holder will ensure CCTV images are securely stored, display an accurate date/time stamp (BST/GMT) and retained for a minimum of 31 days.
The licence holder will ensure that viewable CCTV images are provided in a downloadable format to an officer from a responsible authority within fourteen days of a request.
The licence holder shall ensure a trained member of staff is present on the premises whilst the premises is open to the public, who is able to operate the CCTV system and provided a playback facility to an officer from a responsible authority
The licence holder will promote and ensure that all front of house staff are trained in public safety campaigns such as "Ask for Angela" or other similar schemes. A record of training must be retained for at least twelve months, kept on the premises and made available for inspection by an officer from a responsible authority upon request.
No more than ten customers will be permitted inside the premises at one time.
A lockable counter service hatch must be installed to prevent unauthorised access behind the counter and into the kitchen area.
The licence holder shall take reasonable steps to prevent public nuisance being caused by customers outside the premises and display prominent notices requesting customers respect the needs of local residents.
The licence holder shall ensure litter is collected within two meters of the premises building line, after the premises has closed to the public and at the end of each day.
<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE REPRESENTATION FROM LEICESTERSHIRE POLICE AND THE REPRESENTATION AND AGREEMENT WITH LCC LICENSING ENFORCEMENT TEAM &amp; NOISE AND POLLUTION CONTROL TEAM</b>
The late-night refreshment activities on the below days be restricted to the following: Mondays to Thursdays from 23:00hrs until 02:00hrs, and Fridays to Sundays from 23:00hrs until 03:00hrs.
The opening hours for the premises on the below days be restricted to the following: Mondays to Thursdays from 18:00hrs until 02:00hrs, and Fridays to Sundays from 18:00hrs until 03:00hrs.
<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE REPRESENTATION AND AGREEMENT WITH LCC LICENSING ENFORCEMENT TEAM</b>
The licence holder will ensure a high definition, coloured CCTV camera system is installed, operational and recording whilst the premises is open to the public. The system must permit the identification of individuals at which must be considered in conjunction with Leicestershire Police.

<p>CCTV images must be securely stored, display an accurate date/time stamp and retained for a minimum of 31 days. Cameras must cover all areas that the public have access to, including the entrance/exit and pavement area immediately outside the premises.</p>
<p>The licence holder will ensure that there is always a member of staff trained and available to download images/footage immediately or an agreed timescale if requested by the police or the Licensing Authority.</p>
<p>The licence holder will ensure all incidents are recorded and logged. These records will be kept on site and made available to the authorities upon request.</p>
<p>The licence holder will ensure that a full fire risk assessment will be conducted, reviewed and implemented in line with Fire Safety Legislation annually.</p>
<p>There will be regular safety checks of areas such as entrances/exits and recorded in a logbook which will be kept on the premises and immediately available upon request from any authority officers.</p>
<p>The licence holder shall take reasonable steps to prevent public nuisance being caused by customers outside the premises by displaying prominent Quiet notices requesting customers respect the needs of local residents.</p>
<p>The Licence is subject to Leicester City Council's Standard Conditions for Places of Public Entertainment, published on the Licensing Authority's website <a href="http://www.leicester.gov.uk/licensing">www.leicester.gov.uk/licensing</a></p>
<p>No deliveries to the premises shall take place between the hours of 22.00hrs and 07.00hrs on any day.</p>
