**Report of the Director of Environment, Development and Commercial Services**

**1. Purpose of Report**

The purpose of this report is to present Proposed Responses to objections and other representations to the "Statement of Response to the Inspector's Report and Proposed Modifications" to the Leicestershire, Leicester and Rutland Waste Local Plan (WLP) and to seek authority to move to adoption of the Plan.

**2. Summary**

Following the publication of the "Statement of Response to the Inspector's Report and Proposed Modifications" to the Waste Local Plan, the 3 Councils have to consider all duly made objections and other representations. As a result of this consideration, proposed responses have been formulated for consideration. These amount to 8 minor changes, which do not materially affect the WLP. Once approved, these changes can be incorporated into the WLP and a notice of intention to adopt can be published.

**3. Recommendations**

It is recommended that:

- a) the Proposed Responses to objections and other representations to the "Statement of Response to the Inspector's Report and Proposed Modifications" to the WLP be approved (subject to concurrent agreement being given by Leicestershire County Council and Rutland County Council); and,
- b) the Director be authorised, in consultation with Lead Members, to make any editing or other non material changes that do not alter the principles contained in the WLP, in preparation for the final adoption of the Plan.

**4. Financial and legal Implications**

There are no significant financial implications from proceeding with the Proposed Responses to objections and other representations to the “Statement of Response to the Inspector’s Report and Proposed Modifications” to the WLP. Advertising and publishing costs have been taken into account in Departmental budgets.
