#### AREA STRATEGY GUIDANCE: ST.PETERS LANE

### Report of the Corporate Director of Environment Regeneration and Development

### 1. Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to seek Cabinet approval to adopt Strategy Guidance for the St Peters Lane area as Supplementary Planning Guidance (SPG) to the City of Leicester Local Plan. The draft document is attached as Annex A.

### 2. Summary

SPG for the St Peters Lane was first adopted in April 2000. Since that time there have been a number of factors that have necessitated an update of the guidance. Most notably the proposals put forward in the Leicester Masterplan and findings of the recent Central Leicestershire Retail Study have highlighted the need for more retail space in the city centre. In addition there has been renewed interest from developers to comprehensively redevelop this part of the city centre.

The revised guidance builds on and strengthens the previous guidance in a number of areas. It also proposes in particular;

- a proposed extension of New Walk to cross the site becoming a focus for daytime and nighttime activity.
- the area be strongly linked into the city centre through a series of high quality streets and spaces.
- a new substantial area of open space be provided, ideally as a new 'civic square'.

#### 3. Consultation

Copies of the draft guidance were sent out to a wide range of interested parties. The consultation period ran for 6 weeks and ended on 29 January 2003. Details of the consultation process are set out in the Supporting Information.

Members of the Strategic Planning and Regeneration Scrutiny Committee considered the draft guidance at their meeting on 14 January 2003. Members generally welcomed the draft guidance but made a number of specific comments on matters of detail. See Supporting Information.

A number of relatively minor changes to the guidance are recommended as a result of the consultation exercise. The document attached as Annex A includes these amendments.

#### 4. Recommendation

The Cabinet is recommended to APPROVE the Saint Peters Lane Area Strategy Guidance for adoption as Supplementary Planning Guidance to the City of Leicester Local Plan.

### 5. Headline Financial and legal Implications

The City Council owns land within the area which could form part of any major retailing proposals. It is also possible that the Councils Compulsory Purchase Powers may be needed to assemble land for major development projects in the area.
