51. ADOPTION TEAM ANNUAL REPORT 2002/03

The Assistant Director (Children and Family Services) gave a presentation detailing the annual report and work of the Adoption Team.

It was reported that despite its considerable workload, the adoption team was making significant achievements. This had resulted in a very positive national image. The numerous challenges facing the team were identified for members.

The Committee congratulated the Adoption Team on their successes and

expressed their appreciation for the valuable work of the team. Members asked what measures were being taken to encourage people to get involved in adoption, especially families from ethnic minority backgrounds.

The Assistant Director (Children and Family Services) explained that the reputation of the Adoption Team encouraged word of mouth recruitment. In addition a campaign was being organised with the Leicester Mercury to raise the profile of the service. The difficulties of adoption in ethnic minority communities were discussed.
