


Proposed Saturation Area of the City Centre of Leicester

Police Beats 1 to 11 in Leicester City Centre

Figure 1 shows the Leicester City Centre by defined Police beat areas. There are 11 Beats making up the City centre of Leicester.



Concentration of the licensed premises in Leicester City Centre

This figure shows the concentration of licensed premises already within the police beats 1 to 11 in the City centre of Leicester.

Figure 2 indicated that there are high concentrations of licensed premises on beats: 4, 7, and 9. Similar concentrations are shown on neighbouring beats 1,5,6 and 8.





Figure 3 shows a plan of the Leicester City boundary overlaid with the number of assaults per 100 metres that took place during 2002/03.


The red squares indicate the highest number of assaults. These occur in the City centre of Leicester.

This plan is similar to figure 3 and shows the spread of assaults across the City of Leicester but for the last year 2003/04.

It again shows that the highest concentration of assaults take place in Leicester City Centre.



Assaults by day of week and time of day in beats 7, 8 and 9

(Two months data only Feb & Mar 2004)


Graph 1 plots out the day of the week and times of day when assaults occur on the 7, 8 and 9 beats.

It shows that on most days of the week assaults occur in the evening and early hours of the morning. This is more prevalent as the weekend approaches and peaks From Friday evening into Sunday early morning.

Figure 5 shows an overlay of the concentration of licensed premised in the City Centre of Leicester, together with the highest volumes of assaults per 100 metres in 2003/04.

It can be seen that where there is a high number of licensed premised there are also a high number of assaults.

Figure 6 zooms into this hot spot area in order that street names can be identified.
