9. UPDATE ON PUBLIC SECTOR RELOCATION (THE LYONS REVIEW)

Councillor Thomas declared a non prejudicial interest in this report, as a member of the Leicester and Rutland Probation Board.

The Service Director, Regeneration and the Service Director, Property submitted a joint report updating the Committee on the steps being to attract public sector relocation to Leicester. The Committee felt very strongly that strenuous efforts should be made to attract government departments to the City because of the economic benefits it would bring.
