	At 11:14pm on Sunday 08 <sup>th</sup> June 2014 Leicestershire Police received a telephone call from a concerned member of the public telling them that a person had been 'glassed' in the pub.
	A member of the public had been drinking in the premises at the time and was so concerned had returned home and informed her partner of the 'glassing'
	At 11:39pm officers attended the pub and reported there were few people in the premises, none with injuries however it was believed that an altercation had taken place between 2 males but the 'landlord' did not know about this.
	The person identifying himself as the person in charge was Hardial SINGH.
	Officers later returned and viewed CCTV which shows a male assault another in the face inside the pub.
	Hardial SINGH now admits to Officers that he believes a glass was used in the altercation inside the pub and he had cleaned it up. This has effectively removed evidence from a crime scene.
	Hardial SINGH further stated that he had been asked not to contact the police. This indicates that he is unable to control customers rather than promote the licensing

Leicestershire Police are concerned that the licensing objectives are being and will continue to be, undermined whilst the present management of Hardial SINGH, premises licence holder and Brinderjit SINGH, Designated Premises Supervisor remain in place.

Hardial SINGH was the Designated Premises Supervisor at the premises until removed following a review application by Leicestershire Police in September 2006.						
Hardial SINGH continued to be the Premises Licence Holder for the venue and in this capacity has control over the premises.						
Branderjit SINGH, who is the son of Hardial, is the present Designated Premises Supervisor.
