

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The restrictions in this Annex do not prohibit any sale, supply or consumption of alcohol previously permitted by the Licensing Act 1964.

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

In this condition, permitted hours means:

- On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 10 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m. b)
- On Good Friday, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m. C)
- On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 10 a.m. to 11 p.m. d)
- On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m. e)
- On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).
- On Christmas day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the chief executive of the justices for the petty sessions area in which the premises are. The said hours shall:
 - i) not exceed six and a half hours;
 - ii) not begin earlier than 12 noon;
 - iii) not end later than 10.30 p.m.
 - iv) provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.;
 - v) not extend for more than three and a half hours after 5 p.m.

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

Licensable activities may continue between the end of the hours permitted by the licence on New Years Eve and the start of the hours permitted by the licence on New Years Day.

In accordance with section 49 of the Licensing Act 1964 persons admitted to the Club in connection with Club functions, who are not members of the Club, may consume on the premises intoxicating liquor supplied to them by or on behalf of the Club, in the same way as it may be supplied to members, provided that the number of any such functions in any one year shall be limited to twenty.
