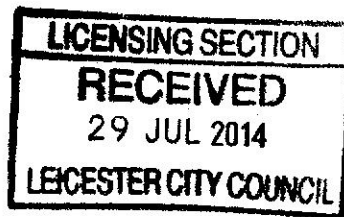

Dear Sir,

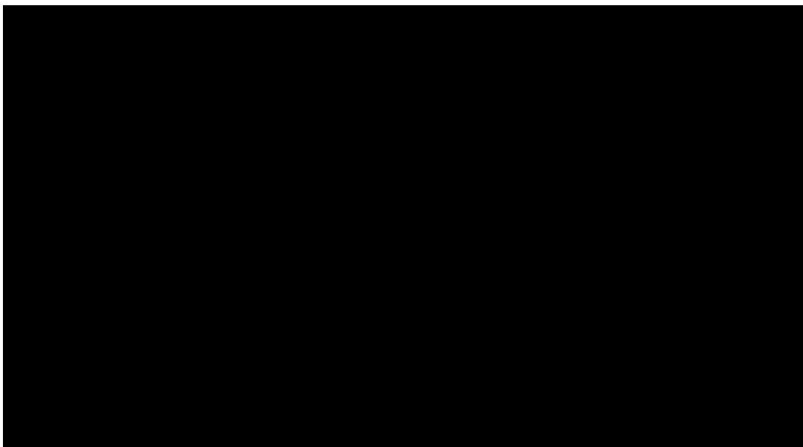
We wish to protest in the strongest possible manner, against the application made to Leicester City Council by the Carisbrooke Lawn Tennis Club, for a permit for extended opening hours for the serving of alcohol, along with recorded music, dance and live music. We wish to object against 2 out of the 4 Leicester City Council licensing objectives;

- The prevention of public nuisance and
- The prevention of crime and disorder.

Carisbrooke Lawn Tennis Club is situated in the heart of a very quiet residential area, which forms part of the Knighton estate. This proposed development will certainly be detrimental to the peace and tranquility of this residential area, which we believe the residents in this area of Leicester should be able to continue to enjoy without the intrusion of the late night noise and disturbances that will inevitably follow the granting of this application.

In addition we would argue that granting such a license to what is effectively a sports club is totally at odds with the purpose and ethos of such a facility. We have no objection to the occasional granting of license for specific one-off events at Carisbrooke Tennis Lawn Tennis Club, but we wish to record our strongest objections to the granting of blanket permission for extended opening hours for the sale of alcohol and live or recorded music.

| <p>our key concern is that of noise and disturbance caused by large numbers of people (the club holds 120 people for parties and events), consuming alcohol and dancing to live and recorded music <u>beyond</u> normal opening hours ie 11pm</p> <p>Carisbrooke Road is a quiet residential area, and the bedrooms at Carisbrooke Court, which is situated next to the Carisbrooke Lawn Tennis Club, are only 30 feet from the tennis courts.</p> |

Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives

We believe that it is wholly inappropriate to extend the license to what is supposedly a sports facility, enabling that facility to become a late night venue for drinking and dancing.

Such an extension may well lead to greater levels of crime and disorder in the area and will most certainly increase the levels of public nuisance.

In addition we would like it noted that we have not been able to assess the full proposal, because your computing system is not fully operational, and that we are not convinced that the blue notice that is required to be displayed for 10 days on the entrance has actually been displayed.
