<p>The application does not include any proposal to prevent public nuisance. The premise has caused a nuisance previously when the club house was used for a function that included recorded music. I therefore recommend that the application as it stands is refused.</p>



**Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives**

In March 2014 the Carisbrooke Tennis Club clubhouse was used for a function that included loud music. The music was clearly audible across neighbouring residential premises at 2320 hours, affecting the occupiers of several houses, and I confirmed that the volume of the music was sufficient to cause a statutory nuisance when I visited one of the affected houses.

I visited the club and confirmed that the clubhouse, where the event was taking place, was a light weight building with no significant acoustic insulation.

The submitted plan does not clearly indicate whether this is the building proposed for licenced activities, and so I will arrange to visit the premise to investigate this, and to decide what conditions may be required on the licence to prevent any further noise nuisance.

The application does not propose any measures to prevent nuisance, nor any explanation of why such measures are unnecessary, and I therefore recommend that this application as it stands is refused.
