Due to this it is designated under the councils special policy as a cumulative impact area. These premises have a condition stating that the premises will be licensed primarily</p>

as a restaurant with on sales only and at the hearing for that licence application on the 10th May 2012 members wanted to ensure that in granting the licence the premises would remain as a restaurant in the future .

This application appears to be the start of a series of TENs aimed at sidestepping the condition attached by the committee and will enable 3 floors to be used as a night club.
