Please summarise your concerns about this application:
<p>I write in my capacity as Inspector for the Leicestershire Police on the authority delegated to me by the Chief Constable.</p> <p>My representation relates to all four of the licensing objectives.</p> <p>This is an application for a restaurant that intends to trade until Midnight every day of the week.</p> <p>It is situated within the cumulative impact area of Granby Street, London Road, and the area bordered by Highfield Street, Sparkenhoe Street, Conduit Street and London Road. This is an area that has previously suffered from incidents of anti social behaviour connected with 'street drinking'.</p> <p>The applicant has made no reference to the cumulative impact area within his</p>

application and therefore has made no specific indication of how these premises would not impact on the area.

Our primary concern is that should these premises obtain a licence that it remains a restaurant.

Our further concern is to ensure that the licence holder has a suitable framework to ensure the licensing objectives are fully met.

Whilst not wishing to restrain the discretion of the Committee the police ask that the following steps be considered to complement those steps already supplied by the applicant should they decide to grant this licence.

- (a) Alcohol will only be sold to customers who are purchasing a substantial meal.
- (b) The license holder will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Leicestershire Police and maintained in accordance with the Information Commissioners CCTV Code of Practice. Images will be kept for a minimum of 31 days and made available to the Police and responsible authorities within 24 hours of a request being made.
- (c) The licence holder will ensure all incidents of crime or disorder will be reported to the police and recorded in an incident book to be kept at the premises which will be made available to responsible authorities & police on request.
- (d) The license holder will ensure all staff are trained in the 'Challenge 25' policy and that suitable signs relating to Challenge 25 are displayed in the restaurant.
- (e) The licence holder will ensure a refusal book is maintained and kept at the premises and made available to responsible authorities and police on request.
