

**CONDITIONS**

<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH OPERATING SCHEDULE</b>
The licence holder will do a full risk assessment of the premises to cover all four licensing objectives.
The licence holder shall fit and maintain a CCTV system
The licence holder will operate a proof of age scheme such as Challenge 25
The licence holder will ensure that anyone who appears to be drunk and/or aggressive will not be allowed on the premises
An incident book and a refusals register will be kept on the premises at all times and records will be kept of any incidences of violence, theft or attempts by people suspected of being underage attempting to buy alcohol
All staff will be trained in the licensing objectives and how to uphold them
The licence holder will make sure litter is regularly cleared from the external areas around the premises
The licence holder will discourage drinking and anti-social behaviour in the vicinity of his premises
All customers will be asked to leave the premises quietly
Staff will be given training, which will be recorded, in relation to age restricted products, including consistent operation of a recognised proof of age scheme.
Staff will ensure that any children on the premises are supervised by the adults accompanying them
The licence holder will ensure staff are trained to vigilant regarding proxy sales of alcohol

<b>CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH REPRESENTATION FROM THE POLICE</b>
The licence holder will ensure that all staff, paid or unpaid, are trained in responsible alcohol retailing, including the licensing objectives, at six monthly intervals and that this training is documented and signed for.
The licence holder will operate and maintain a refusals register which will be kept on the premises and made available to the responsible authorities on request.
The licence holder will maintain an incident log which will be kept on the premises and made available to Police and Responsible Authorities on request. All incidents will be reported to the police.
The licence holder will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Leicestershire Police and maintained at all times the premise is open to the public and will be kept to a minimum 31 days. Recordings will be made available to the police and responsible authorities within 48 hours of a request for the recordings being made.
The licence holder will provide training to all staff, paid or unpaid, working at the premises in relation to Challenge 25 and will adopt this as the premises "age policy". This training is to be documented and repeated a minimum of twice a year to retain focus
The licence holder will display notices to inform customers that they will be asked for proof of age if they appear under 25 to the person selling the alcohol
The licence holder will display signs to inform customers not to purchase alcohol for or on behalf of anyone that has not reached 18 years of age
The licence holder will ensure that no alcohol is consumed on the licenced premises
