I write in my capacity as the applicant in relation to the above premises.

Discussions have taken place with the Leicestershire Police in relation to the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

I am aware that representations have been made that the following conditions and amendments to licensable hours should be placed upon the new licence:

The sale of alcohol and the time the premise is open to the public to be reduced by one hour daily with the terminal hour for both of 2300hrs.

1. The licence holder will ensure that CCTV is installed and maintained in accordance with the Commissioners Code of Practice for CCTV. Recordings will be maintained at all times the premises are open to the public and these recordings will be retained for a minimum of 31 days.
2. The licence holder will make recordings from the CCTV available to the Police and responsible authorities within 48hrs of a request for those recordings being made.
3. All staff will receive suitable training (including refresher training) in relation to the proof of age Challenge 25 scheme to be applied on the premises. The following forms of identification are acceptable:- photo driving licence, passport, proof of age standards scheme (PASS) card and UK Armed Forces Military Identity Card where the date of birth is shown.
4. No single cans of beer, lager or cider will be sold.
5. All spirits will be behind the counter
6. There will be no display of alcohol within 3 metres of any entrance/exit except for spirits displayed behind the counter.
7. The licence holder will continually risk assess the need for SIA guards and act accordingly.
