This is an application to vary the sale of alcohol with an increase of alcohol sale on Monday to Thursday by one hour from 2300hrs until midnight and on Friday & Saturday by 3 hours until 0200hrs.

The applicant in his application has made no reference to the impact the extension of these hours would have on the cumulative impact area and therefore it must be considered that they have not reflected on this when submitting the application.

These premises are situated on Hinckley Road which is within the cumulative impact area as adopted by the Licensing Authority.

The area is very popular due to the bars of Braunstone Gate and sees an increase in footfall as the weekend approaches. It is also within an area of high student accommodation with the University campus close by.

Within the cumulative impact area there are currently 5 'off licences', 2 'on' licences and 4 late night refreshment licences granted on Hinckley Road.

On Narborough Road there are 13 'off' licences, 14 'on' licences & 8 late night refreshment licences.

On Braunstone Gate & New Park Street there are 16 'on' licences and 4 late night refreshment licences.
