REVISED STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS FOR 1999/2000

REPORT OF THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER

1. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

- 1.1 The revised Statement of Accounts was given an unqualified audit opinion by the District Auditor on December 2000.
- 1.2 The Accounts and Audit regulations 1996 require the Council to approve the changes made to the draft accounts following the audit.
- 1.3 Attached to this report is a full copy of the Statement of Accounts for 1999/2000 and additional copies have been lodged in the Members' area.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 At its meeting on 18 September 2000 the Cabinet approved a report on the draft Statement of Accounts of the Authority for the year ended 31 March 2000. The accounts were presented subject to audit.
- 2.2 The District Auditor has now completed the audit of the accounts, and has given an unqualified opinion on them. In his management letter for 1999/2000 he has commented that there have been further improvements in the preparation of the accounts, and that the audit again went well overall.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 Cabinet is recommended to note the revised Statement of Accounts for 1999/2000.
