## 24. LEARNING DISABILITIES - INTEGRATION AND LEAD COMMISSIONING ARRANGEMENTS

As having declared a prejudicial interest in this item as a Non Executive Member of Leicester West Primary Care Trust the Chair, Councillor J Blackmore left the meeting room during consideration of the item. With the agreement of Councillor Almey, Councillor Mrs Chambers took the Chair for this item.

The Corporate Director of Social Care and Health submitted a report which set out proposals for new lead commissioning arrangements and the progress made in implementing integrated Health and Social Care Learning Disability services to be hosted by the Council.

It was stated that it was proposed to introduce lead commissioning by the local authorities of health and social care services for people with learning difficulties across Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland. For the City it was proposed that a single Commissioning Board for Learning Disability Services be set up with a pooled Health and Social Care budget from October 2005, underpinned by a formal partnership agreement.
