CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The licence holder will ensure that a CCTV system is installed and maintained, to monitor entrances, exits and other parts of the premises.

The licence holder will ensure that a Challenge 25 policy is in operation at the premises, and that staff are fully trained to implement this policy.

Internal and external lighting will be installed so as to promote public safety.

Any lighting on or outside the premises will be positioned so as to not cause disturbance to nearby residents.

A log book or recording system will be kept on the premises and be made available for inspection when required by persons authorised by the Licensing Act 2003 or associated legislation.

Deliveries of goods necessary for the operation of the business will be carried out at such a time or in such a manner as to prevent nuisance and disturbance to nearby residents.

Movement of bins and rubbish outside the premises will be kept to a minimum after 11.00 pm.

A clear and legible notice will be placed outside the premises, indicating the normal hours during which licensable activities are permitted.

Prominent, clear and legible notices will be displayed at the exit requesting customers and staff to respect the needs of nearby residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

The licence holder will ensure that custom is not sought by means of personal solicitation outside or in the vicinity of the premises.

Customers will not be admitted to the premises other than during permitted opening hours.

The Designated Premises Supervisor will be in day to day control of the premises and provide training for staff in relation to the Licensing Act 2003.
