CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The licence holder will ensure Digital CCTV will be in operation and recordings will be retained for 31 days and will be available to the Police or other responsible authorities on reasonable request.

The licence holder will ensure no irresponsible sales promotions of alcoholic beverages shall be offered to customers.

The licence holder will ensure no customers carrying open or sealed bottles, shall be admitted to the premises at any time that the premises are open to the public.

The licence holder will ensure a sign will be located on the premises indicating the standard hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.

The licence holder will ensure a sign will be located at exits, requesting that customers leaving the premises do so quietly and with consideration to neighbours. During the performance of regulated entertainment, all windows and doors shall remain closed except for entrance and exit from the premises.

The licence holder will ensure anyone who appears to be under the age of 25 and who is attempting to purchase alcohol must be required to produce proof of age before such a sale is made.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE REPRESENTATION FROM LEICESTERSHIRE CONSTABULARY

The licence holder will ensure that there is always a member of staff on the premises whilst it is open to the public, who is trained to operate and provide images from the CCTV system to Police officers and responsible authorities.

The licence holder will ensure that Security Industry Authority licence holder(s) will be employed at the premises on each Friday and Saturday from 21.00hrs until the cessation of business on those days and at any other time following advice from Leicestershire Police or the licence holders own risk assessment identifies a requirement for door supervisors.

The licence holder will ensure a risk assessment is completed for events which are outside the scope of normal business and liaise with Leicestershire Police at least 48hours before that event takes place.

The licence holder will maintain an incident book to record all incidents at the premises of crime and disorder, damage to property and personal injury. This book is to be retained at the premises made available to police and responsible authorities on request and retained for a minimum of 12 months.

The licence holder will ensure all incidents of crime which lead to injury, disorder and damage to property are reported to the police.

The licence holder will join City Watch Leicester Against Crime and ensure the designated premises supervisor is an active member.

The licence holder will ensure that all staff, paid or unpaid, will receive training relating to Responsible Alcohol Retailing and the Licensing Act 2003 which will include preventing under-age sales, proxy purchasing, serving to drunks and conflict management. This training will be documented, completed annually and signed for on completion by the trainer and trainee or if completed on-line by the production of a relevant completion certificate.
