- (b) The licence holder will ensure that there is always a member of staff on the premises, whilst it is open to the public, who is trained to operate and provide images from the CCTV system to Police officers and Responsible Authorities.
- (c) The licence holder will ensure that Security Industry Authority licence holder/s will be employed at the premises on each Friday and Saturday from 2100hrs until the cessation of business on those days and at any other time following advice from Leicestershire Police or where the licence holders own risk assessment identifies a requirement for door supervisors.
- (d) The licence holder will maintain an incident book to record all incidents at the premises of crime and disorder, damage to property and personal injury. This book is to be retained at the premises made available to police and responsible authorities on request and retained for a minimum of 12 months.
- (e) The licence holder will ensure all incidents of crime which lead to injury, disorder and damage to property are reported to the police.
