Representation

I wish to make representations in connection with the application for a temporary event notice (TEN) for 19th March 2016 12 noon to 3.00am as I consider this proposal will be detrimental to the licensing objective of public nuisance.

REASONS:

Complaints have been received with regards to noise from this premise, and on 9th October 2015 at 0030 hours Chloe Roper from the Noise and Pollution Team witnessed loud music and drumming from the premises, despite both internal front doors to the premises being closed.

The music was clearly audible in the street at the rear of the premises, and was sufficiently loud to affect many local residents. From Ms Roper's observations it is clear that the fabric of the building will not contain even moderately loud music, and noise breakout sufficient to cause a nuisance is very likely.

In addition the application states that the event will be attended by up to 200 people. This number of people leaving the premises at any time after 2300 hours will cause a significant disturbance to residents in the area.

In summary the proposed event is very likely to cause a nuisance to many local residents, and consequently I recommend REFUSAL of the application for a TEN.
