CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The licence holder will ensure CCTV is installed inside and outside the premises. Images will be stored for 31 days and a member of staff will be able to operate, replay and export images.

The licence holder will ensure the Challenge 25 policy is operated at the premises. Acceptable identification for the purpose of age verification will include a driving licence, passport or photographic identification bearing the PASS logo and the persons date of birth.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE REPRESENTATION FROM LEICESTERSHIRE POLICE

The licence holder will ensure that all staff, whether paid or unpaid, are trained in responsible alcohol retailing and the Licensing Act 2003 at six monthly intervals. The contents of the training are to be documented and records kept with the date and signature of both trainer and trainee.

The licence holder will operate and maintain a refusals register which will be kept on the premises and made available to the responsible authorities on request.

The licence holder will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Leicestershire Police and maintained in accordance with the Information Commissioners CCTV Code of Practice.

The licence holder will ensure CCTV will record at all times the premises is trading under its premises licence with the recordings kept for a minimum of 31 days and made available to the Police and/or Licensing Authority within 24 hours of a request being made.

The licence holder will not offer for sale or sell any beers, lagers, ciders or perrys where the alcohol by volume (ABV) exceeds 5.5%
