BINS ON THE STREET

We have a new procedure for dealing with Black wheelie bins being left on the street after collection day, so if there is a problem on your street more than 2 bins left out then please report this to us ASAP as this process can take up to 3 months from start to finish.

NEW FIXED PENALTY NOTICE

In the next few Weeks there will be a new fixed penalty amount for fly tipping there are now two levels. Level **1** is £80 and is issued for littering such as cigarette ends, crisp packets etc. Level **2** is £250 for any thing bigger than one bag of rubbish this is also discounted for early payment.

We are still having reports of men doing gardening jobs and rubbish removal for people and not disposing of the rubbish and just fly tipping this has happened at least 4 times on Highmeres road. It is the responsibility of the occupier to dispose of the waste or pass on their waste to a licensed waste carrier and always ask for a receipt if they won't give you a receipt be mindful where your waste might be going so if you are having work done please bare this in mind before you pay any money out. Or you could use the free bulky waste that Leicester city council provide. you can now donate items which are still in good working condition to our PASS IT ON scheme. This scheme provides items to those in need in Leicester. Reusable items will be collected free of charge. you can still book your bulky collections which is up to 5 bulky items every 2 months or 15 bags of garden waste. to find out more call 0116 4541002 or visit Leicester.gov.uk/recycling

WHAT CITY WARDENS DO

City wardens investigate complaints about rubbish in gardens, private land and alleyways. They will take action if there is a statutory nuisance.

City wardens don't clear rubbish dumped in alleyways as this is the responsibility of the occupants of the adjacent properties with access, regardless of who has dumped the rubbish. If we have the rubbish removed by a private contractor, the occupants of each property that has access will be charged
