CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The licence holder will operate the Challenge 21 policy at the premises where only valid forms of identification such as photo driving licence, passport and Home Office approved ID cards displaying the PASS hologram are accepted.

The licence holder will ensure all staff working at the premises are trained and have full knowledge of their responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003 and the Challenge 21 policy.

The licence holder will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Leicestershire Constabulary Crime Reduction Officer and maintained in accordance with the Information Commissioner's CCTV Code of Practice.

The licence holder will ensure a refusal register is kept at the premises and any refusal of the sale of alcohol will be recorded in the register and made available to responsible authorities on request.

Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed requesting customers leave the premises and the area quietly.

The licence holder will monitor the exterior of the premises to ensure litter is kept to a minimum.

A maximum of three unaccompanied children will be allowed in the shop at any one time.

No beer, lager or cider to be sold with more than 5.5% ABV.
