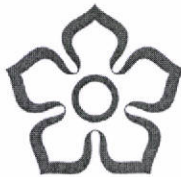

ANNEXES

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises-

- a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
 - i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supplied alcohol), or
 - ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
- e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-

- a) a holographic mark, or
- b) an ultraviolet feature.

The responsible person shall ensure that-

- a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
 - i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
- b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

Admission of children to the exhibition of any film must be in accordance with the recommendations of the British Board of Film Classification for that film. Where permission has been given by the Licensing Authority to show a film not classified by the British Board of Film Classification, the requirements made by the Licensing Authority for the admission of children to the exhibition of that film must be followed.

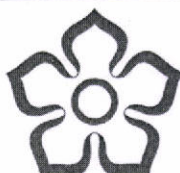
All individual(s) at the premises for the purpose of carrying out a security activity must

- (a) be authorised to carry out that activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Industry Act 2001; or
- (b) be entitled to carry out that activity by virtue of section 4 of that Act.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The licence is subject to Leicester City Council's Standard Conditions for Places of Public Entertainment, published on the Licensing Authority's website www.leicester.gov.uk/licensing.

The maximum permitted number(s) of persons allowed when regulated entertainment is taking place is (are) as follows:

Ground Floor - 300 persons

First Floor - 110 persons

The occupancy to include ALL persons employed within the premises and ALL persons resorting to the premises.

The restrictions in this Annex do not prohibit any sale, supply or consumption of alcohol previously permitted by the Licensing Act 1964.

Licensable activities may continue between the end of the hours permitted by the licence on New Year's Eve and the start of the hours permitted by the licence on New Year's Day.

Licensable activities may take place on all public Bank Holidays (Friday - Monday), Christmas Eve and Boxing Day until 03:00hrs. The opening hours of the premises shall be 03:30hrs on those occasions.

On the morning when summer time begins, alcohol may be sold and regulated entertainment provided until 03.00.

Any employed door staff will wear a name badge as identification.

Each door supervisor will carry proof of his/her registration with the Security Industry Authority.

No customers apparently carrying open bottles upon entry shall be admitted to the premises at any times the premises are open.

Toughened glasses shall be used for draft beer and lager at all times the premises are open to the public.

CCTV is installed with recording facilities such recordings shall be retained for a period of 30 days and made available within a reasonable time upon request from the police.

Alcoholic and other drinks may not be removed from the premises in open containers save for consumption in any external area provided for that purpose.

Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.

Children under the age of 16 shall not be permitted on the premises after 22:00hrs. There shall be no restriction on children under the age of 16yrs when they are attending a private event.

Any door supervisor or any person engaged in similar employment on the premises must be a member of a registration scheme and approved by the Police.

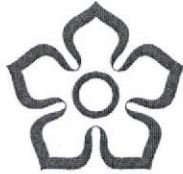
Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the Licensing Authority

The licence holder shall ensure that CCTV is installed following the advice from the Leicestershire Constabulary Crime Reduction Officer and maintained in accordance with the Information Commissioner's CCTV Code of Practice.

The licence holder shall employ sufficient registered door staff to deal with any likely contingency.

Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

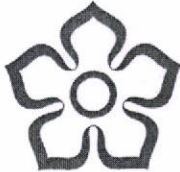
