Report of the Director of Neighbourhood and Environmental Services

1. Purpose of Report

1.1. This report provides information for Members about an application made under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome of that application.


2. Determination to be made

- 2.1. Having considered the application, Members must consider whether to
 - Reject the review application
 - Modify the conditions of the certificate
 - Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the certificate
 - Suspend the certificate for a period not exceeding three months
 - Revoke the club premises certificate
- 2.2 Where Members take the decision to reject the review application, they are permitted to issue an informal warning to the certificate holder and / or recommend improvement within a particular period of time.

3. Summary

3.1 This report outlines an application for a review of an existing club premises certificate for Latimer Conservative Club. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

5. Existing Club Premises Certificate

- 5.1. The existing club premises certificate is attached at Appendix A.
- 5.2. The activities and hours permitted by the existing certificate are as follows:

6. Review application

- An application was received on 30 November 2016 from LCC Noise Team for a review of the existing club premises certificate for Latimer Conservative Club. The application was made on the ground of the prevention of public nuisance. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix B.
- 6.2 The LCC Noise Team has witnessed numerous noise nuisances at this premises which has demonstrated that the club has failed to properly manage the volume of music. They therefore request that a condition is applied to the club premises certificate, as follows: "All live and amplified music shall be played through a noise limiting device of a type agreed with the City Council Noise and Pollution Control Team, set at a level agreed with the City Council Noise and Pollution Control Team"

7 Steps to Promote the Licensing Objectives

7.1 In arriving at its decision on the review application, the Licensing Authority's primary consideration must be the promotion of the licensing objectives.

8. Statutory Guidance

8.1 Any decision made by the Licensing Authority must be in accordance with the licensing objectives. In addition, the government has issued guidance under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. The relevant parts of the guidance in this case are as follows:
