1. Purpose of Report

To seek Cabinet endorsement of spending proposals by Area Committees.

2. Report

As part of the 2005/06 approved revenue budget, Council agreed that £250,000 be allocated for use by Area Committees. At its meeting on 26 September 2005, Cabinet agreed that each of the Area Committees would be allocated £25,000 in the current financial year, with an agreed set of criteria and rules to achieve the release of these funds.

To comply with current Finance Procedure Rules, Cabinet also agreed that any proposals for expenditure from these budgets be reported to Cabinet for approval, thereby enabling them to consider and determine any proposals which are contrary to existing strategic policy provision.

The second set of proposals are set out at Appendix A.

3. Recommendations

Cabinet is recommended to endorse the items of expenditure put forward by the Area Committees, as detailed at Appendix A to the report.

4. Financial Implications
