I have a full time job and find it hard to get up after being kept awake.

My dog has cut her paw on broken glass smashed by one of the customers and I had to seek medical attention from a vet.

The "Please keep the noise down when leaving as this is a residential area" sign makes no difference whatsoever.

Many a time I have shouted out my bedroom window to keep the noise down only to get lots of verbal abuse shouted at me.

The proposed opening hours of 2-30 am closing is absolutely ridiculous as this pub is situated in a residential area. Adults and children all have to get up early in the morning.

I also enclose a petition from some of my neighbours in Leire Street and affected houses in Arbour Road and also Harrison Road.

Many have not signed as the letter put up to propose this closing time is not written in other languages so they do not understand what I am asking.
