The premise is located within a particularly densely populated part of the city, with houses close to the premise. Loud live or amplified music is likely to break out of the premise and cause a nuisance late a night. Customers leaving between midnight and 0230 are also likely to disturb local residents, since it is impossible for customers to leave the area without walking past several houses, whether directly home or to cars parked in the area.


I therefore object to the proposed variation.

I will contact the applicant to discuss potential mitigation measures that can be added as conditions to the premises licence, in particular closing at the existing closing time during the week, and earlier than proposed at weekends to minimise disturbance from customers leaving, and a sound limiting device set at a level agreed with the Noise Team.

<u>Application for variation of premises licence</u> <u>Victoria Jubilee, 112 Leire Street</u>

In confirmation of our phone conversation, I have submitted a representation (objection) following your application for a variation of the premises license for Victoria Jubilee. I have concerns that music late at night from the premises and noise from customers leaving may be detrimental to local residents of flats opposite the premises.

I will be able to withdraw my representation if you agree to conditions on the licence as we discussed, namely ceasing licenced activities and closing at times earlier than originally proposed in the application for a variation, along with music being played through a noise limiting device.

I have enclosed an agreement for you to sign and return to the City Council Licensing Team which, if you are happy for the agreement to be included on any license granted, you should return to the Licensing Team. The address is on the agreement.

I understand that other representations have been made to the Licensing Team. If these are valid objections then a licensing hearing will be held. The agreement with regard to noise will be presented to the Licensing Panel during the hearing. The Licensing Team will contact you directly with regard to this.
