| <p>I refer to the above-mentioned application for a new premises licence for 49-53 Granby Street, Leicester. My representation relates to the prevention of Public Nuisance. The application includes the provision of Recorded and Live Music.</p> <p>Hours requested Mon-Sun: 08.00 hours – 04.00 hours</p> <p>The premises are adjoined to a number of residential flats on Belvoir Street, Leicester. On the first floor of the premises there is a glass window on the Belvoir Street façade which significantly reduces the sound reduction capacity of the façade. Should this premises be allowed to provide live and recorded music, the sound will be transmitted directly and through the fabric of the building into adjoining residential flats.</p> <p>I am concerned that if the hours requested are permitted and the premises is allowed to have amplified music (both live and recorded), it is likely that noise nuisance will</p> |

occur.
